## PREPARING TO APPLY

- Complete Group A Courses:**

- Complete Group B Courses:**
  - Sociology 220 or Anthropology 130
  - Psychology 130 or 220
  - Speech 120, 121 or 128
  - Psychology 126, 128 or PE 197
  - Information Competency LIBST 110a (beg. Fall 2011)
- NURS 212, Pharmacology for Nurses (or its equivalent), may be taken as a prerequisite or co-requisite of the first semester. This course may be challenged; call (510) 235-7800, ext. 4267 for information.

## SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION PACKET (OCTOBER 1 - FEBRUARY 1)

- Obtain CCC and Nursing Program Application from the college Admissions & Records Office, or online at [www.contracosta.edu/courses/nursing/index5.htm](http://www.contracosta.edu/courses/nursing/index5.htm)
- Submit all of the required materials together as a packet, to the Admissions & Records office.
  - 1. Completely fill out all application forms.
  - 2. Include official transcripts for all college courses completed.
  - 3. Follow application deadline dates. (October 1 - February 1)
  - 4. Clearly mark your packet envelope and any correspondence as "Nursing Application."

## GETTING ACCEPTED

- Written letter of notification of acceptance has been received.
- Submit your reply, the **Acceptance Form**, to the Nursing Department, HS-103, by the date stated in the letter.
- Take the TEAS test at the assigned date & time and pass with a cut score of 67. You may need to schedule an appointment with the Nursing Program Assessment Test Project Coordinator.

## PREPARING TO START

**Prior to entering the program, have the following completed:**

- Current CPR card (American Heart Association Provider C).
- Physical Examination form completed.
- All titers and/or immunization results recorded on CCC Health Form:
  - Tuberculosis (TB) - two step test (or chest x-ray)
  - Hepatitis B series
  - Varicella
  - Rubella
  - Rubeola
  - Mumps
- Complete criminal background check and drug screening.
