

SCHOLARSHIPS

There are two scholarship opportunities. Both are need based:

COLLEGE FOR KIDS GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$125—\$250)

SAN PABLO (Resident) YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP (\$250—\$500)

The deadline for the scholarship application and all supporting documents is

JUNE 9th at 4:30pm

THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.

Before you apply, please be aware of the following

- Awards are need based and are limited in number.
- Past CFK behavior and class participation will be taken into account in addition to your application materials.
- LATE or INCOMPLETE applications will not be considered and will be returned.
- Scholarship donations will impact the number of awards available.
- You must pay for all classes at the time of registration, scholarships are awarded as course refunds.
- Payment for all classes INCLUDING SCHOLARSHIP COURSES is due at the time of application
- Payment **cannot** be withheld while awaiting scholarship determination as in previous years.

To complete the scholarship form:

- Complete all steps on the appropriate scholarship form
- Make sure to indicate the course in which the student wishes to enroll and the time the course meets. *Please provide at least one alternate!*
- Remember to include a recommendation from a teacher AND the student statement.
- Provide a copy of low-income status. *(Approved documentation is listed on each form).*
- Attach the completed *Registration Form* and *Emergency/Behavioral Contract*.
- Mail the completed scholarship application along with all registration forms to the **address on the bottom of the form. Packets may also be submitted in person.**

If your student is awarded a scholarship

- Scholarship award letters will be mailed the week of June 20th. *(Tentative)*
- Scholarship awards will be processed no sooner than June 20th for classes which have been paid for in cash or by credit card.
- If you paid by check we will refund the amount of the scholarship as soon as the check clears the bank per notification of our Cashier's Office.
- Students must maintain satisfactory course progress and behavior during the program. If the student receives a poor progress report or multiple behavior referrals, the scholarship may be revoked at the discretion of the CFK Program Director or designee.
