<b>April 18 -24</b>	<b>Spring Recess</b>
Apr 26-May 9	Preregistration for returning, new matriculating, and exempt students**
May 10	Preregistration for new non-matriculating and K-12 concurrent enrollment students begins
<b>May 30</b>	<b>Holiday -- Memorial Day</b>
June 12	Last day to register online or by phone prior to first day of instruction***
June 13	First day of instruction for almost all courses (verify your course start date in the Schedule of Classes)
June 13-17	Late Add Period (students must obtain a late add code from the instructor)
<b>July 4</b>	<b>Holiday -- Independence Day</b>
July 21	6 week classes end (confirm for each course)
August 4	8 week classes end (confirm for each course)
August 4	Last day to petition for a Summer degree/certificate
<b>FINAL EXAMS</b>	Usually held during the last scheduled class meeting. Be sure to confirm with your instructor.
<b>SPECIAL NOTICE ABOUT OTHER SUMMER SESSION COURSE DEADLINES:</b>	
<p><i>Summer session deadlines of the type noted below vary greatly due to the different lengths of summer courses. Students are advised to find and note on their calendars these deadlines. The deadlines for each of your courses is printed to the right of each course when you access "My Schedule" in WebAdvisor.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><i>o - Last day to add or drop with eligibility for fee refund (approx. 10% of the class)</i></li><li><i>o - Last day to choose Pass/No Pass grading option (approx. 30% of the class)</i></li><li><i>o - Last day to withdraw from a full-term class without a "W" (approx. 30% of the class)</i></li><li><i>o - Last day to withdraw from a course with a "W" (approx. 75% of the class)</i></li></ul> <p><b><i>It is the student's responsibility to know these deadlines and abide by them.</i></b></p>

** A new matriculating student is one who has completed the online orientation. Assignment of a preregistration appointment to this time period is automatic.	
*** Students may register online or by phone up to midnight, the day prior to the first class meeting.
