¹ This will require the very early submission of their petition (i.e. no later than 9/15/11 for a SP12 degree/certificate).

Additional changes planned for implementation for Fall 2012:

- Recent high school graduates will be added to group 3 and will have a higher priority than continuing students with 100 units or more.
