Petitioners must submit written evidence showing that they have acquired at least 40 hours (for 119) or 100 hours (for 120) of appropriate laboratory experiments that correlates to the laboratory experiments presently performed in the course for which credit is requested. 2. Examples of such evidence could be laboratory notebooks or protocols that the petitioner has completed. This written evidence must then be approved by at least two department faculty members before the petitioner is then invited to an oral interview conducted by at least two department faculty

	members. 3. If the candidate is deemed to be sufficiently well-prepared, then s/he is given a written exam that is scored and a letter grade is given based solely on the petitioner's exam performance.
