

2018-2019 Verification of Homeless Youth Status Form

AB 801 amended Education Code section 66025.9(b)(2) to state that "Homeless unaccompanied youth" means a student **under 25 years of age** who has been verified, at any time during the **24 months immediately preceding the receipt of his or her application for admission**, to meet the definition of "homeless unaccompanied youth." This determination may be made by a Financial Aid Administrator (FAA) based on a documented interview with the applicant.

"Homeless unaccompanied youth" is defined in subsection (2) of Section 725 of the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. Sec. 11434a(2)) as the following:

Homeless Children and Youth:

- Individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. The term includes children and youth who:
 - Are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason;
 - Are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations;
 - Are living in emergency or transitional shelters;
 - Are abandoned in hospitals;
 - Are awaiting foster care placement;
 - Have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings;
 - Are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Unaccompanied:

- Not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

To be considered a "homeless unaccompanied youth" the student must meet BOTH definitions.

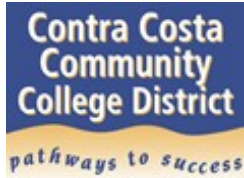
