| August 27 | First day of instruction |
| September 3 | Holiday -- Labor Day |
| September 7 | Last day to add a full-term course |
| September 7 | Last day to drop full-term classes with eligibility for fee refund |
| September 7 | Last day to withdraw from a full-term course without a "W" appearing on transcript (in person) |
| September 8-9 | Saturday/Sunday courses begin |
| September 9 | Last day to withdraw from a full-term course without a "W" appearing on transcript (WebAdvisor) |
| September 10 | Census for full-term courses |
| September 21 | Last day to choose Pass/No Pass (P/NP) grading option for full-term courses |

| October 15 | Last day to petition to graduate for Fall 2018 term |
| November 1-30 | Filing period for continuing and returning students with over 100 degree applicable units or on second semester probation or dismissal who want to appeal their spring registration date |

| November 16 | Last day to withdraw from a full-term course with a "W" appearing on transcript |
| November 16 | Last day to add or adjust a variable unit course |
| November 22-23 | Thanksgiving Holiday |

| December 10-16 | Last week of Instruction |
| December 14 | Last day of instruction for Fall - Weekday classes |
