

FALL 2020 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

March 1 – April 15	Filing period to submit early fall graduation application to receive early registration appointment for fall
April 1 – May 18	Filing period for continuing and returning students with over 100 degree applicable units or on second semester probation or dismissal who want to appeal their registration date
May 18 – 19	Priority registration for EOPS, DSPS, Veterans, Foster Youth, and CalWORKs students
May 20	Priority registration for DSPS notetakers, early graduation petitioners, and intercollegiate athletes
May 21 – June 2	Priority registration for continuing students and Middle College HS students who have completed the Student Success Program**
May 25	Holiday – Memorial Day
May 28	Priority registration for graduating high school seniors who have completed the Student Success Program**
June 3	Priority registration for new students who have completed the Student Success Program** and returning students with less than 100 degree applicable units
June 8	Registration for continuing and returning students with over 100 degree applicable units or on second semester probation or dismissal
June 11 – 12	Registration for new students who did not complete the Student Success Program** and exempt students
June 22	In-person registration for concurrent special admit high school students
August 1 – September 15	Filing period for early graduation petitioners to apply for priority registration for spring
August 24	First day of instruction
August 29-30	Saturday/Sunday courses begin
September 4	Last day to add a full-term course in person
September 4	Last day to drop full-term classes with eligibility for fee refund
September 7	Last day to withdraw from a full-term course without a “W” appearing on transcript (in person)
September 7	Holiday – Labor Day
September 8	Census for full-term courses
September 24	Last day to choose Pass/No Pass (P/NP) grading option for full-term courses
September 25	Holiday — Native American Day
October 15	Last day to petition to graduate for fall term
November 1-30	Filing period for continuing and returning students with over 100 degree applicable units or on second semester probation or dismissal who want to appeal their spring registration date
November 9	Holiday – Veterans Day
November 13	Last day to withdraw from a full-term course with a “W” appearing on transcript
November 13	Last day to add or adjust a variable unit course
November 26- 29	Thanksgiving Holiday
November 28 – 29	No Saturday/Sunday courses
December 11	Last day of instruction for fall – Weekday classes
December 13	Last day of instruction for fall – Saturday/Sunday classes
December 22 – January 3	Winter Recess – CONTRA COSTA COLLEGE IS CLOSED
