SPECIAL NOTICE ABOUT SUMMER SESSION COURSE DEADLINES:

Summer classes, the dates to add, receive a refund, or drop are calculated individually for each course based on the length of the course. For detailed class- class specific deadline dates, log into your Insite account and select "My Class Schedule." You may also check with your instructor who has this infromation on their class roster.

Students are strongly advised to record these deadlines in your personal calendar.

Date calculation guidelines:

- Last day to add or drop with eligibility for fee refund (10% of the class)
- Last day to withdraw from a full-term class without a "W" (20% of the class)
- Last day to choose Pass/No Pass grading option (30% of the class)
- Last day to withdraw from a course with a "W" (75% of the class)
- Last day to enroll in or adjust units for an open entry/open exit variable unit class (75% of the class)

It is the student's responsibility to know and understand all college deadlines
