- Attend the next ASU Senate meeting and participate in the 4 week probation period. Meetings are held every Wednesday from 4:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

 - Attend an interview with ASU Senate members. The interview will be scheduled during an ASU meeting.

After you have completed your interview, the ASU Senate will discuss and vote on your appointment in their next meeting. You will be informed of the decision immediately after the vote.

ASU RESPONSIBILITIES

Required:

- Must attend all ASU Senate meetings unless excused with prior notice to the ASU President.
- Complete a minimum of two (2) office hours per week. These office hours allow the opportunity for interactions between a Senator and their constituency.
- Participate in at least one (1) college-wide committee and provide reports at ASU Senate meetings.
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA and be enrolled in 5 of more units at Contra Costa College.

Weekly Time Commitment

Most Senators can complete their responsibilities in 6-8 hours per week. However, many often choose to put in more time. How much you want to be involved is up to you!
